Their goals included doing quality checks of existing cave maps, and then doing some new cave surveying. While visiting the caves they did a basic biological inventory, as well as human impact assessment. Accessing some of the bluffside cave entrances required steep, somewhat treacherous approaches. The three caves visited were: Goose Tunnel Cave, Buzzard Slot Cave, and Two Buzzard Tunnel Cave.

On Jan 7th 2026 Dillon joined the Lake of the Ozarks Grotto, to visit Rock House Cave (historically aka, Jim Henry Cave). Dillon recounted some of the history regarding the cave, including Jim Henry and his family's use of the cave as a home for many years.
